Drawing with Perspective


Goal:


We will draw this simple landscape using a step-by-step guide. Please follow the directions closely.




Step One:

Make guidelines by folding the paper.








Step One:

Draw a line under the middle guideline.

This is where the horizon is (where the mountains start).




Make guide lines. Draw horizon.

Step Two:

Draw the road.

It should be bigger at the front and smaller near the horizon line.




2. Draw the road.

Step Three:

Add two lines in the middle of your road.


They should get closer together near the horizon line.



Add the center road line.

Step Four:


Draw two big trees.



4. Draw two large trees.

Step Five:

Draw two smaller trees behind the big trees.




5. Draw two smaller trees.

Step Six:

Draw four more trees.

They should get smaller and smaller as they get closer to the horizon line.




6. Add four smaller trees.

Step Seven:

Draw some mountains!


The bottom of the mountain is the horizon line.



7. Draw the mountains.


Step Eight:
